

FROM FATHER SIMON



Thank you, dear people of Queen of All Saints! Through your generosity, over 400 individuals will have a smile on their faces and gratitude in their hearts as they open their Christmas gifts. In a special way I want to thank the members of our St. Vincent De Paul Society for their tireless work to help us ‘Share Christmas’ with those in need. They procure the lists, make sure the names are on the tree for us to pick up, sort out the gifts with the help of student volunteers and ensure they are delivered to the parishes and organizations. Thank you for bringing joy to children and families.

‘JOY’ – that is the theme for the Third Sunday of Advent. This Sunday is called ‘Gaudete Sunday’. The opening antiphon for today’s liturgy asks us to *“Gaudete in Domino semper”* - “Rejoice in the Lord always”. Today, on our Advent Wreath we light our pink candle to mark this day of joy because as the antiphon tells us *‘The Lord is very near’*.

So what should we do? That was the question the people asked John the Baptist and he told them to be generous, just, honest, grateful and compassionate. In this season of joyful expectation, when you try to get done as many things as you can I want to remind you of the words of Saint Paul in his first letter to the Thessalonians: “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing”. We can also reverse the order of these two phrases: “Pray without ceasing, so that we will be able to rejoice always.”

This year, the Filipino American Community Association of Queen of All Saints Basilica (FACA) marks the 30th year of celebrating Simbang Gabi at our parish. On each of the nine mornings leading up to Christmas, Filipino Catholics gather in the pre-dawn hours for Simbang Gabi, a novena of Masses that anticipates the celebration of Christmas. The timing of the Mass, which begins as early as 4 a.m., helps make the event special and highlights the seasonal sense of anticipation. The experience of rising early in the morning and traveling to church in the dark adds an element of sacrifice to this season of preparation. I invite you to join our parish celebration of Simbang Gabi Mass on Saturday, December 22 at 7:00 p.m. and then, at our reception following the Mass, enjoy an abundance of Filipino culture, food and hospitality.

2017-2018 FINANCIAL REPORT TO THE PARISH

Last week's bulletin, an email on Tuesday, and the entrances around church, all have had our Financial Report posted. In that was the following message and request from our Finance Council...

We know that we have many faithful supporters, who provide for their church on a regular basis. We are extraordinarily grateful for their efforts. Without them we would not be able to be where we are today.

- We have not made a vigorous appeal for a Sunday collection increase for several years, but now we must. At this time, we ask that you **increase your Sunday offering ideally by a minimum of 20%**, and hopefully more if you can afford it. We know that many of our parishioners stretch themselves to support our parish, which is why our average Sunday envelope contains about \$35 per week. Others certainly have the ability to support our parish beyond that average.
- We also ask those whose circumstances permit to increase their capital campaign pledges.
- We ask those who have not yet pledged or are new to our parish and are benefitting from the generosity of the past to make a pledge.

We know that our fellow parishioners always do the right thing when they are given the facts, and that is why we confidently lay before you the situation we now face.

The 3rd Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday, meaning "Rejoice." Stewardship is, of course, based upon an "**attitude of gratitude**" and today is a day to focus on the joy that results from that gratitude. Father Henri Nouwen was a well known Catholic priest, professor, writer, and theologian. In describing the significance of this particular day, Father Nouwen clarified the difference between joy and happiness.

He said, "While happiness is dependent upon external conditions, **joy is the experience of knowing that we are unconditionally loved by God** and nothing — not sickness, failure, emotional distress, oppression, war, or even death — can take that love away. Joy can be present in the midst of sadness."

This "joy" that is reflected in lives of stewardship was also emphasized by Pope Francis, who has said, "Today is a day of joy. Rather than fretting about all we have not done or accomplished to prepare for Christmas during Advent, **we need to think of all the good things God, and life, has given us.**"

Please consider what we can give back to our parish, in our time, our talent, and our treasure, in response to the great gifts God has given us.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.


