## FROM FATHER SIMON



The feast of Corpus Christi is the last Sunday in the long festal period of the liturgical year. It began with Ash Wednesday, reached a pinnacle at Easter and continued through to Pentecost. Next weekend we return to the Sundays in Ordinary Time. Corpus Christi offers us a moment in which to look back on it all, and to give thanks for it all.

Gratitude is an abiding thing. You aren't grateful if you just say 'thanks' and forget it. You are grateful when you spend time consciously being grateful for what has been given to you and what you have. You savor it. You relish it. It is a powerful and ongoing experience.

I think the feast of Corpus Christi is appropriate for this. The Lord's Supper isn't just something that Jesus did and that we simply remember. It is something that creates, recreates, sustains our living union with the crucified risen One and binds us to each other in him. What we are grateful for is not just in the past, it is still happening, now. It will never stop.

We do give thanks to God for the whole mystery of it. However, we are not the only ones giving thanks. Jesus also gives thanks. 'While they were eating, he took bread. Giving thanks he broke it and gave it to them... He took the cup, and giving thanks, he gave it to them.' He is the one who has always been giving thanks. He is not casually grateful because someone has given him food and drink. He is grateful for God's call to him to give himself as food and drink to us. He thanks God for letting the bread be his body for us – his body which gives us new life. He thanks God for letting the wine be his blood for us, as we drink it and enter the covenant. He is always giving thanks.

In the Old Testament giving thanks was a way of life for God's chosen people. Being a grateful people is what sets us apart. Today I invite you to take some time out of your busy and over-scheduled lives to be with Jesus who is truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. Let us take this opportunity and make gratitude the prayer of our heart, for gratitude is the heart of all prayer.



# STATUS OF OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

We are now within days of completing the construction of Phase 1 of our capital campaign, the near total re-building of the Benedict Center. Once we get occupancy of that building we will be able to move back in during the summer and complete the transformation of that space from a 20% use of a long-neglected building to a 100% use of state-of-the-art early childhood education classrooms and an assortment of comfortable meeting spaces for our growing adult ministries.

*This is a dream come true for a parish that values its children. It is also a necessity for a parish with so many adults who wish a deeper involvement in learning about their faith and in living their faith.*

But as we catch our breath at the completion of Phase 1 we immediately pivot to Phases 2 and 3, the renovation of space in our Lemont and Keene Avenue buildings for use by our school, renovating the former kindergarten space into the largest new space for our adult ministries, and finally concluding with the restoration of the former Rose Room in the basement of the Lemont building to its original purpose – a parish hall!



All of this comes, of course, at a price. Anyone who has gone through a home renovation knows the expense that comes with progress, even with good planning and careful oversight. Our project is certainly no exception, and we also have the extra cost of building for long-term and very heavy use, plus the cost of unexpected construction surprises inherent in older buildings.

## But right now I have two urgent requests.



First, as we have already noted very often in our progress reports in the bulletin and elsewhere, the final cost of all our needed improvements will be at least \$6 million. We have received pledges of direct donations to our parish of roughly \$5.2 million. **We have collected 61% of those pledges to date**, but the pace of collections has slowed due in large part to the multi-year nature of those pledges. We always keep a close eye on our ultimate costs and the most cost-effective way to complete our dreams is to continue our pace of construction and that will require us to accelerate our pace of pledge collections. **Please make every effort to stay current on your donation to our parish and even perhaps to complete your donation early.** There may also be some tax advantages under the new tax reform laws to accelerate the total payment of your donation this year in 2019.

Second, as we noted above, there is still a gap between donations to the parish and our final cost. Our fund-raising effort remains open to those whose circumstances may have improved since their initial pledge or who may feel more confident in making an initial pledge or increasing their earlier pledge. **If you are able, please stretch your commitment to our parish's future by making or increasing your direct donation to our parish.** All of us have benefitted from the efforts of others, from both the distant past and from the more recent past. **It is time for all of us to stand as one as we strengthen our parish for the bright and hopeful future we all share.**





## Stewardship: Understanding our Parish Finances

We rely on three main sources of funds:

**Sunday, Holidays, UPP** — This is our regular revenue and is by far the largest source of funds to pay for our parish operations. In a sense, this is what “keeps the lights on” by paying for our staff, our routine repairs, maintenance and other day to day costs of running the parish.

**Long-Term Savings** — We are blessed with savings resulting from the generosity of the past, including parish and school endowments. The earnings from these accounts is used to supplement our regular revenue to balance the budget and on occasion, pay for extraordinary repairs. We have recently drawn upon our savings deeply to pay for the unanticipated basilica repair costs, specifically the ceiling project, bell tower project and other repairs. Now we need to take steps to replenish those savings. **We need a significant increase in our Sunday collections to pay back and restore our savings back to prudent level.**

**Capital Campaign** — Our capital campaign is aimed at making our older buildings (the Benedict Center, the Lemont and Keene Avenue buildings) more suitable for today and tomorrow’s needs. This includes making better use of space for school needs and for the needs of our increasing number of lay ministries. **Our new construction projections require us to raise our pledge target from \$5,000,000 to \$6,000,000, and we have already raised \$200,000 of that new target.** Please consider how you can help us reach our new goal.

*We believe that a well-informed parish membership deserves an explanation of parish finances. Please be as generous as you can in supporting our parish and the many ways it touches and helps all of us at all times of our lives.*

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptism Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
